

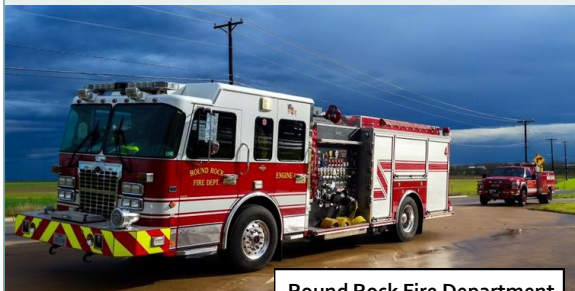

Program: The Club provided:

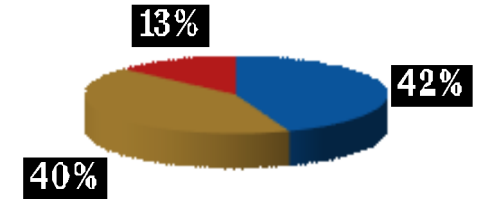
- Support to the families of one fallen and five critically injured first responders

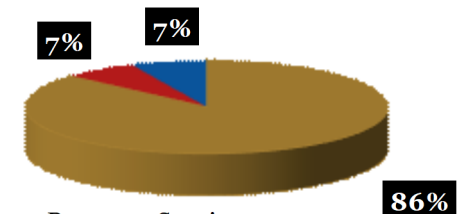
