CRITERIA

Nominees will be evaluated on the following guidelines:

Outstanding Administrative Technician

- Provides exemplary assistance to field personnel
- Creates systems or processes to simplify office work
- Provides a product or attitude which the department could not work without

Outstanding Emergency Communications Operator

- 911 Operator or Dispatcher who goes beyond the call of duty to protect the lives of first responders and/or the public

Outstanding Emergency Medical Technician/Firefighter/K9/Law Enforcement Officer

- Went above and beyond the call of duty in a particular incident
 - Showed exemplary bravery or skill
- *One award will go to each*

Outstanding Team Award

- Demonstrated ability to work seamlessly as a team
- Outstanding group work ethic, including ability to protect public and each other
- Went above and beyond the call of duty in a particular incident

Lifetime Achievement

- Additional community service or contributions to the department throughout career
 - Going beyond job description or call of duty to streamline processes, assist the public, etc.
- *Nominee may be retired or active duty*
