Nominees will be evaluated on the following guidelines:

Outstanding Administrative Technician

- Provides exemplary assistance to field personnel
- Creates systems or processes to simplify office work
- Provides a product or attitude which the department could not work without

Outstanding Emergency Communications Operator

 911 Operator or Dispatcher who goes beyond the call of duty to protect the lives of first responders and/or the public

Outstanding Emergency Medical Technician/Firefighter/K9/Law Enforcement Officer

- Went above and beyond the call of duty in a particular incident
- Showed exemplary bravery or skill
 *One award will go to each

Outstanding Team Award

- Demonstrated ability to work seamlessly as a team
- Outstanding group work ethic, including ability to protect public and each other
- Went above and beyond the call of duty in a particular incident

Lifetime Achievement

- Additional community service or contributions to the department throughout career
- Going beyond job description or call of duty to streamline processes, assist the public, etc. *Nominee may be retired or active duty
